Frequently Asked Questions:

1. Will the ** cover fit the **** product?**

If two products have the same physical exterior dimensions, and if the handles are in the same positions, the cover of one will indeed fit the other. Further, the covers do not generally fit all that snug. In some cases, there may be a good chance the available cover of one amp may fit another amp if their dimensions only differ by a few millimeters or so (handle orientations notwithstanding). Dimensions for a particular product are often provided among its respective specifications on the Marshall website (if current) or a catalog it would've been featured in. The owner's manual(s) may also have the product dimensions listed. If dimensions are not listed in these resources, taking a physical measurement of the length, width, and height of the product in question (using a ruler or tape measure) would be the way to go.

2. The product I need a cover for is older and isn't listed here. Is there a cover available for it?

Probably not, but the answer to FAQ # 1 can apply here as well. Additionally, if the product in question is a full-size tube head, especially one that was manufactured since 1981, most of these heads have the same (or nearly the same) dimensions and use the same cover. That said, they are all lumped into the same category (see the first cover listed on this chart). For example, this would apply to all the different full-size head model numbers from the JCM800, JCM900, JCM2000, or JVM series.

3. The product I need a cover for is new and isn't listed here, is there a cover available for it?

Possibly. Information regarding parts and accessories, such as covers, may not be available immediately after a product's announcement or release. This chart will be updated with new cover part numbers as soon as possible after the information becomes available. It is also quite likely that a new cover part number will not be issued if an available cover already exists for another past or present model with the same dimensions and handle orientation. See also FAQ #1.

4. The cover listed has since been discontinued. Is there a replacement?

If it is a significantly older product that does not have similar enough dimensions and handle orientation as another product with an available cover, a replacement part number is unlikely. If a part number is discontinued, please inquire with Korg USA Customer Service for possible replacement parts information. Please also notify product support so the cover chart can be updated. For those interested in searching elsewhere for used or new old stock (NOS) covers, discontinued covers will not be deleted from this list.

5. May I custom-order a cover?

No, Marshall does not offer such a service at this time. If Marshall does not issue a particular cover, or style of cover, you may wish to contact a third party vendor or manufacturer. A preexisting generic cover from another manufacturer may already accommodate the dimensions and handle placements of certain products. Some companies that specialize in cover manufacturing may also accept custom orders if they do not already offer a prefabricated product that meets the customer's wants or needs. Many musical instrument retailers already stock generic covers or can also order from these companies on the customer's behalf. Some cover companies may also sell direct to consumer. While a number of options exist, one recommended cover company is Tuki Covers: www.tukicovers.com or 1-800-344-8854.

6. I ordered a new cover (or more than one cover) and the color of the script Marshall logos do not match the other Marshall covers. Some are gold, others are white. What gives?

Marshall is transitioning to white logos on their covers. Most prior Marshall vinyl dust covers featured painted gold Marshall logos. Marshall has confirmed that once their current cover stock has been used, all logos will revert to being white on all covers. Any stock of covers that has been replenished before the older stock has completely sold out may have a mixture of both logos.

7. Does Marshall currently offer any single covers that will cover an entire half-stack or full-stack?

No (with the exception of the MG15 Micro Stack cover, COVR00098). In the interest of safety, and to avoid property damage, when carrying or transporting, each item in a setup should be carried separately.
